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Cycling South Africa Inter-Provincial Competition Rules

Inter-Provincial Competition

The Inter-Provincial Competition forms part of the Cycling South Africa (CSA) Junior Road Championships and is administered by the CSA Road Commission.

Purpose

The objectives of the Inter-Provincial Competition are to:

- Provide an opportunity for riders in the Under 11, Under 13, Under 15 and Under 17 age categories to represent their provinces in the Road Race, Individual Time Trial and Criterium disciplines.
- Provide provinces with a platform to award Provincial Colours where applicable.
- Assist provinces in achieving their rider development and transformation objectives.
- Encourage participation and healthy competition between provinces.

Competition Format

The competition will be contested during the CSA Junior Road Championships and will include the following events:

Date	Event
25 September 2026	Criterium
26 September 2026	Individual Time Trial
27 September 2026	Road Race



Eligible Categories

The following age categories will be eligible for the Inter-Provincial Competition:

- Under 11
- Under 13
- Under 15
- Under 17

Both male and female riders in each category are eligible.

Team Composition

1. Each province may nominate a maximum of three (3) riders per gender in each age category.
2. The maximum provincial team size is therefore 24 riders.
3. The official list of nominated riders must be submitted to the Chief Commissaire or Race Secretary at the Team Managers' Meeting on 24 September 2026.
4. Once submitted, no rider substitutions will be permitted except where approved by the Chief Commissaire under exceptional circumstances.

Competition Rules

1. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the Cycling South Africa Rules and Regulations.
2. The Chief Commissaire shall have the final authority regarding the interpretation of these rules and the resolution of any disputes.
3. Provincial points will be accumulated across all three championship events.

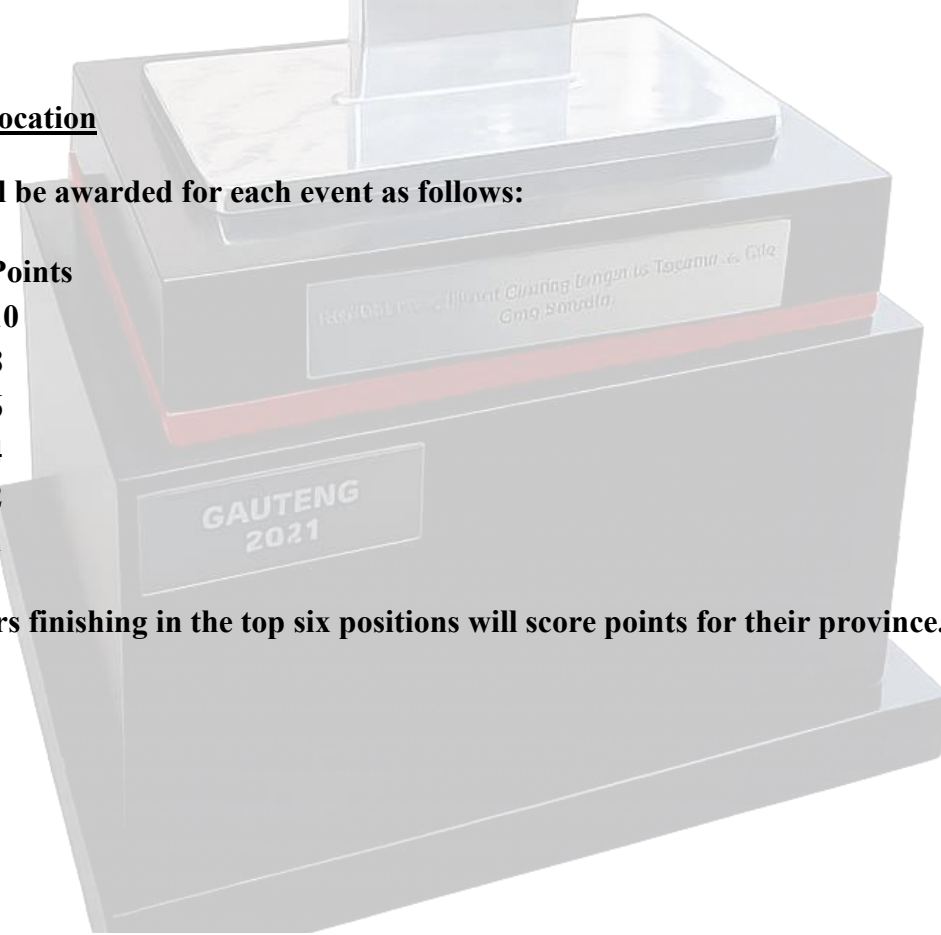
Points Allocation

Points will be awarded for each event as follows:

Position Points

1st	10
2nd	8
3rd	6
4th	4
5th	2
6th	1

Only riders finishing in the top six positions will score points for their province.





PDI Bonus Points

All Previously Disadvantaged Individual (PDI) riders who score points will receive double points for their province.

For example:

- 1st Place = 20 points
- 2nd Place = 16 points
- 3rd Place = 12 points
- 4th Place = 8 points
- 5th Place = 4 points
- 6th Place = 2 points

Overall Provincial Winner

The province with the highest cumulative points across all eligible age categories and championship disciplines will be declared the Inter-Provincial Champion.

Tie-Break Procedure

Should two or more provinces finish on equal points, the final standings will be determined in the following order:

1. The province with the greatest number of PDI riders.
2. The province with the greatest number of female riders.
3. The province with the greatest number of participating riders.

If a tie still exists after applying the above criteria, the CSA Road Commission and Chief Commissaire shall determine the final ranking.

Definition of a Previously Disadvantaged Individual (PDI)

For the purposes of this competition, a Previously Disadvantaged Individual (PDI) is defined in accordance with Section 9(2) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996, and includes the following designated groups:

- Men of African, Asian or Coloured descent;
- Women, irrespective of race or descent; and
- Persons with disabilities, irrespective of race or descent.
